Another innovation on display is the SpeedStar Compact, an electric jetting head designed for ultra-precise adhesive application. It applies millimeter-sized hot melt dots and short beads with consistent accuracy on small flaps and narrow spaces throughout its service life of 500 million operating cycles. With 800 dots per second SpeedStar Compact is ideal for fast and precise gluing of primary packaging.
